Sophomore applicants who are selected receive \$7,500 their junior and senior years

Junior applicants who are selected receive \$7,500 their senior year

Honorable mentions are selected as well but receive no financial support







Purpose and Expectations

- "Identify and support college sophomores and juniors who show exceptional promise of becoming this Nation's next generation of research leaders in these fields
- Strong commitment to a research career in the natural sciences, mathematics and engineering
- Effective display of intellectual intensity in the sciences, mathematics and engineering
- Potential for a significant future contribution to research in his/her chosen field.

Selection Criteria

- 1. Be a full-time matriculated sophomore or junior pursuing a degree at an accredited 2- or 4-year institution of higher education during the 2017-2018 academic year
- 2. Intend to pursue a research career in a natural science, mathematics or engineering
- 3. Have a college grade point average of at least a 3.00 on a 4.00 scale
- 4. Be a U.S. citizen from the 50 states or the District of Columbia; a U.S. national for those students nominated by institutions in Puerto Rico, Guam, Virgin Islands, American Samoa, and Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands; or a permanent resident.

 - a. Questionnaire, Research Essay, Letter of Recommendation, Transcripts

Important Application Dates

- 1st Tuesday in September Online Application Opens
- Early September Late January Individual internal campus deadlines
- Last Friday in January Nomination deadline (5:00 PM CT)
- Late February Nomination packets reviewed
- Mid-March- Board of Trustees vote on Scholars/Honorable Mentions
- Last Friday in March Scholars/Honorable Mentions Announced (11:00 AM Central Time)

Survey of Scholars

Recipients between 1989 through 2013 revealed that:

- 99% of all Goldwater scholars have at least one degree (bachelor's degree or higher),
- 49% have earned PhDs in science, mathematics or engineering,
- 72.6% of Goldwater Scholars report current involvement in ongoing scientific, mathematics and engineering research.
