A summer internship is available for majors in Chemical Engineering with a small start-up company (GP Ionics, LLC) located on campus at NMSU.

Hours: 20 to 30 hrs/week.

Description: The internship includes several aspects in the development of instrumentation for chemical measurements including:

- a. experimental activities with studies on flows of air with small diaphragm pumps in closed loops
- b. assembly of analyzers for chemical measurements
- c. preparation of standards to test technology for analytical performance
- d. data analysis and preparation of findings in written form
- e. some computational modeling is possible
- f. participation in company meetings
